The Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills (DIBELS) are a set of procedures and measures for assessing the acquisition of early literacy skills from kindergarten through sixth grade. They are designed to be brief fluency measures used to regularly monitor the development of early literacy and early reading skills. This workshop is designed for educators who have not had previous experience with DIBELS. The training will include an overview of the foundations of DIBELS and will offer in-depth training and practice on administering and scoring all of the recently released and updated DIBELS Next measures. Discussions regarding the use of the DIBELS as a universal screener to support buildings and districts using Response to Intervention practices will also be included in the training.
